US FPA VISITORS REVEALED

THE TEAM USA Scholarship winners who will contest the Formula Palmer Audi Autumn Trophy have been named.

Californians Patrick Barrett (17) and Joel Miller (19) will contest the six-race series, which takes place over two meetings at Brands Hatch and Snetterton in October and November.

Barrett is currently leading the Pacific Formula Ford 2000 Championship, while Miller heads the Skip Barber points table.

Team USA Scholarship winners have raced in the FPA Autumn Trophy since 2005, when JR Hildebrand took part in the series. Last year's representative, Dane Cameron, won the series outright.

Barrett (first right), who started his car racing career with victory in

last year's Formula Russell Championship, said: "I'm really looking forward to this opportunity and hope that it will open more doors in my future. Winning the scholarship means a lot to me."

Kart graduate Miller (below, right) added: "Racing in Europe in

a competitive series has always been a goal of mine, and now the scholarship is making that a reality."

The scholarship judging panel included 1996 Champ Car Champion Jimmy Vasser and team owner Dale Coyne.
